The Cuddle Lop Cabin Rabbitry

Congratulations on your new bunny! When you adopt from The Cuddle Lop Cabin Rabbitry, you're welcoming a hand-raised, temperament-tested, boutique-quality companion. Your bunny has been socialized daily, handled gently, kept indoors in a climate-controlled environment, fed organic non-GMO food, and health-monitored every single day.

1. First 48 Hours

Keep the home quiet and peaceful. Allow your bunny to settle slowly. Avoid overwhelming them with visitors or handling. Do not introduce other pets yet. Expect mild soft stool or slight diarrhea from stress—this is normal.

2. Feeding

Your bunny goes home with 2 days of pellets and high-quality hay. Continue the same pellets for 7–10 days. Provide unlimited hay and unlimited fresh water in a bowl (not a bottle—bottles stick and can cause dehydration).

3. Housing

Indoor-only housing is required. Provide a temperature-controlled space free from drafts. Never exceed 80–85°F, and avoid freezing temperatures unless fully shielded from wind. No outdoor grass or dirt exposure due to parasites. Minimum cage size 24"x36", but bigger is always better.

4. Litter Training

Your bunny can be litter trained. Use a rabbit-safe litter box. Place hay next to or over the box. Use paper-based litter only. Expect accidents—babies learn gradually.

5. Handling & Socialization

Your bunny has been hand-raised from birth. Support their entire body when lifting. Begin with short

bonding sessions and let the bunny come to you. Patience builds trust and confidence.

6. Health & Veterinary Care

A vet visit within 72 hours is required to activate your health guarantee. Watch for stress signs: refusal to eat, no droppings for 12 hours, repeated diarrhea, lethargy, or loud breathing. If concerned, contact a vet immediately.

7. Stress Signs

Temporary digestive upset, hiding, or reduced appetite are common the first few days. This is normal transition behavior and should stabilize.
